

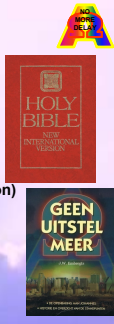

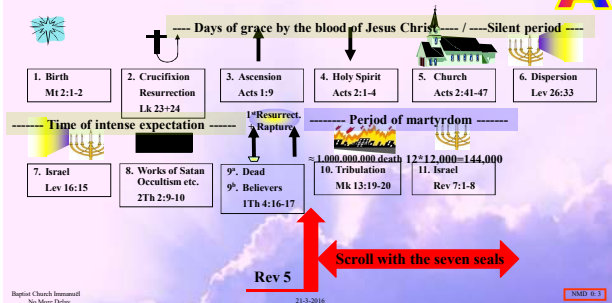

5.5: Opening ceremony

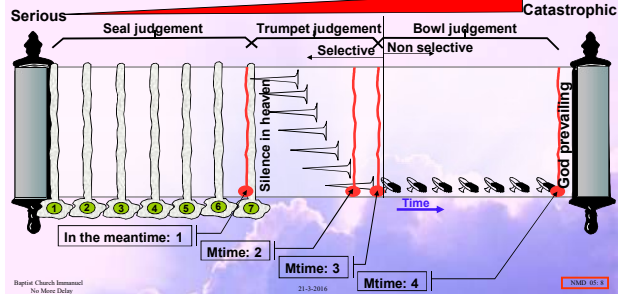
- Opening ceremony book with the 7 seals. Rev 1:19
- Difference with other historical books; it happens now. 2Pe 3:13
- The termination point is: Satan's work finished; End of sorrows; Israel converted; New Jerusalem descended; New heaven and a new earth with justice.
- Many things happened with a tremendous struggle. Everybody is asked to take the scroll and open seals.
- Nobody is worthy or present.
- God has offered his Son for this difficult job.

5.6: John distressed

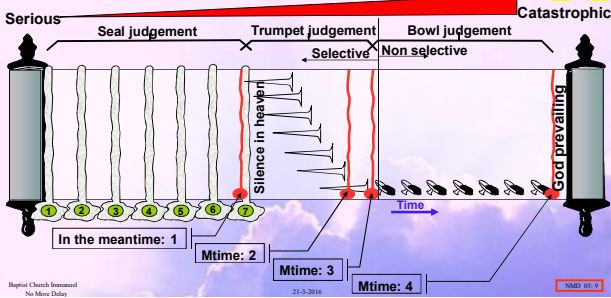
- John wept because no-one was found worthy. Rev 5:4
- One of the elders said: "Do not weep" See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah is able to Ge 49:9-10 Jer 23:5-6
- John expects a Lion but sees a Lamb! "Look the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" Jn 1:29
- Da 9:26 and Isa 11:2,3 They thought He was cut off and exterminated. BUT: 7 horns acknowledge his power for victory; 7 eyes acknowledge God's powerful Spirit vitality
- John wiped his tears away when he recognised the Lord Jesus Christ.
